

Penn Forest Streams POA President

The president shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation and shall have general supervision over the business, and operations of the corporation, subject however, to the control of the board of directors.

The president shall have the power to prepare, certify, sign, execute, and acknowledge, in the name of the corporation, deeds, mortgages, contracts, declaration amendments, or other instruments authorized by the board of directors, except in cases where the board of directors, or by such laws or statutes as may control, or by these bylaws, to some other officer or agent of the corporation; and, in general, shall perform all duties incident to the office of the president, and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the board of directors.

The President assigns elected Board members to departments, tasks, and related duties; and oversees all functions of the association's business.

The President assigns committees and related tasks.

The President will be the Director supervising the administrative office functions and its personnel.

The President presides at Board and Annual meeting as chairman, and assists in preparing all required reports to be presented to the membership or the Board.

Personnel assignments and departments are subject to review and serve at the pleasure of the President.

The President may call for a special meeting at any time when needed.
